Halifax Waterfront - Partial Boardwalk Closure + Routing Map

Please note that the Halifax waterfront boardwalk between the Boat Shed (next to Maritime Museum of the Atlantic) and the south side of The Cable Wharf is closed.

This closure is necessary to advance construction of the Queen's Marquee District.

The image included provides alternate route information in red to help you plan your activity around the waterfront.

Businesses located in the area of construction, including Murphy's the Cable Wharf, NovaScotian Crystal and Maritime Museum of the Atlantic, are accessible and remain open for business.

Together with The Armour Group, Waterfront Development is working hard to mitigate construction impacts for the public and for businesses.

Waterfront Development is currently working on plans for a temporary, floating pedestrian boardwalk which is expected to be in place this spring/summer.

Queen's Marquee District is a mixed-use commercial, retail, hotel and residential development that will include 75,000 square feet of public space and three new wharves in the heart of the waterfront. For more information please visit queensmarque.com
